ADVOCACY SERVICE: SWC offers an advocacy service in partnership with Washington Mind.

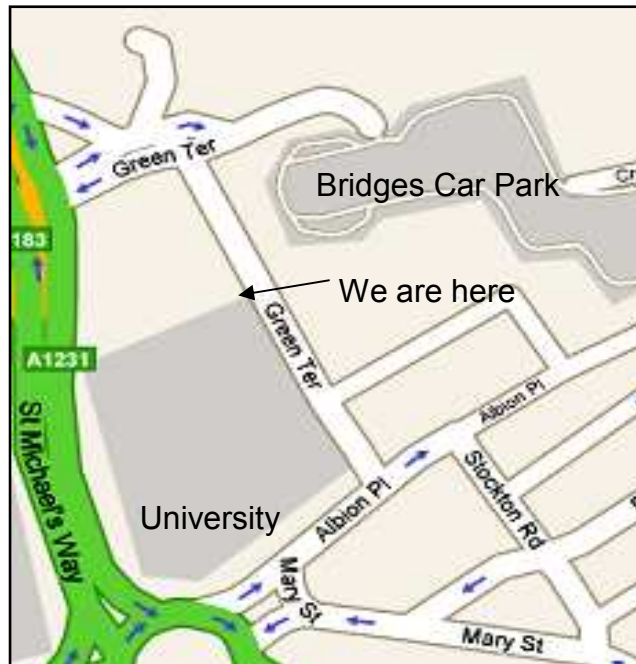

English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)

Learners can study Edexcel qualifications from Entry Level 1 up to Level 2. The course is aimed at improving all aspects of English language including; Speaking & Listening, Reading and Writing. This course is recognised by the Home Office UK Border Agency. The course is full time, consisting of 12 hours per week.
